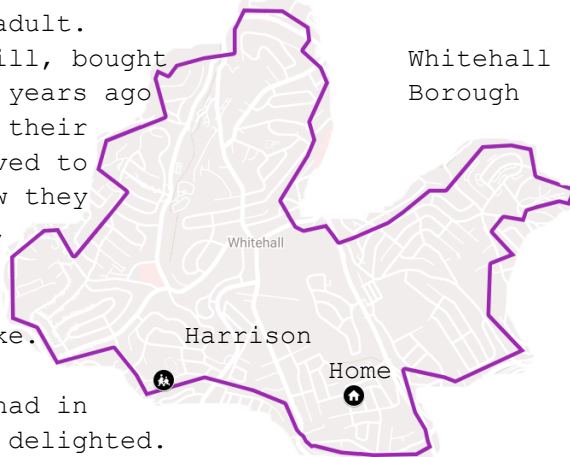


BETH LYNN EICHER ATTENDS & FILMS EVERY COUNCIL MEETING

These ballots are due on election day at 8PM at your county office. For Whitehall, that is Allegheny County, Elections Division, 542 Forbes Avenue, Pittsburgh, PA 15219. Allow up to a week before the election if you put your ballot in the mail which is Halloween, Tuesday October 31. Be sure to sign and date your outer envelope before mailing.
